Level 2 externally accredited Foundation Certificate in Equine Assisted Services. Externally Accredited by AAHEP and the ACCPH for both CPDs and CEUs as well as recognised for CPD by the IACP.

This externally accredited Level 2 qualification can be taken as a standalone Foundation Certificate recognised by insurers or as a pre-requisite for the externally accredited Level 4 and Level 5 Equine Assisted Services Diploma training programmes (providing eligibility for application to be on the first and currently only UK National Accredited Practitioner Register regulated in the UK by an independent governmental body, the Professional Standards Authority (or the non-UK equivalent).

Donkeys: This Level 2 qualification can also be undertaken with a donkey extension and dual certificate awarded for Donkey Assisted Services.



What is the time commitment?

- **ONSITE** *four full days of onsite experiential group learning and personal reflective practice;*
or

- **ONLINE** *a minimum of 42 hours over seven consecutive weeks interactive, experiential, distance learning (access to horses is required between the sessions)*

You will be able to really start to understand, develop and deliver work as an independent practitioner and build on the practical skills of the work with the support of the Athena training team and community (depending on your background and qualifications this can either be referred to as Equine Facilitated/Assisted Learning or Therapy (*i.e. Occupational Therapy, Counselling and, if appropriate, Psychotherapy*), provided you have the appropriate supporting qualifications). Material and a set of Equine Insights (cards) is provided to you to support you on your journey.

- **On completion of the Foundation Certificate, YOU are eligible to:**

- be a **lifetime Member** of Athena's national and international community at **no extra cost** which includes a private facebook community group within which referrals for work are made, knowledge is shared, CPD and CEU events as well as free annual networking events are shared;
- access to your unique log-in area with client and waiver form templates for your use (with more templates provided as your journey progresses);
- include your details on the Athena Members map on the athenaherd.org website;
- display your unique Member logo on your own website and link back to the Athena website (Athena can provide website/brand support as an addition);
- apply to join AAHEP international professional membership as a Student Member;
- apply to join the international professional membership through the ACCPH: see accph.org.uk;
- apply for insurance to cover your work for example through Balens, Holistic and for wider requirements do take a look at Westminster Indemnity insurance policies through athenaherd.org.

Athena also has international relationships with insurers in different jurisdictions that recognise its programmes including for example Equisure and Westminster Global both in the USA.

Continuation to the externally accredited Level 4 Equine Assisted Services Diploma (a further 158 hours so a minimum total of 200 hours) Externally Accredited by AAHEP and the ACCPH also for both CPDs and CEUs as well as recognised for CPD by the iacp (Irish Association for Counsellors and Psychotherapists).



On successful completion of the externally accredited Level 2 Foundation Certificate in Equine Assisted Services, you can continue your journey and build on your specialism whether that be working with individuals and/or groups, children and/or adults, looking to garner funding for the work, work with children, vulnerable adults, and/or corporates and move on to complete the **externally accredited Level 4 and Level 5 Equine Assisted Services Diploma as follows:**

- (i) **Level 4 (ONLINE):** three practical case-studies involving a minimum of twelve sessions overall supported with supervision, delivery of a case study and mentoring plus two facilitated online group action learning sets and personal research. The goal is to really develop and build both on your practice from one session with a client(s) to supporting multiple client(s) sessions along with enhancing those questioning and clean language skills with of focus on being trauma informed; **and**
- (ii) **Level 4 (BLEND OF ONLINE AND ONSITE):** interactive online topic learning and sessions to further develop and build on your practice (mindfulness and grounding, embodiment and somatic practices, empathy and social intelligence ensuring a trauma informed practice) supported also by the business and risk mitigation aspects including the provision of further appropriate templates (incorporating your business and considerations around data and insurance, risk assessments, policies and procedures, garnering funding and much much more).

For a more tailored approach to your learning, You can swap out the business-related sessions on the externally accredited Level 4 Equine Assisted Services Practitioner Diploma for **one alternative topic as follows:**

- Working with young people
- Understand the nature of horses (Equine ethology) and the implications for Equine Assisted/Facilitated work
- Mental Health awareness and support, and wellbeing benefits
- Capturing and recording the benefit of your work
- Working with Mindfulness
- Working with Corporate Clients

Please note that the externally accredited Level 4 Equine Assisted Services qualification can be taken as a full distance learning option with the submission of one extra online practice client session or you can opt to spend two days onsite.

- (iii) **Level 5 Equine Assisted Services Diploma (a further 100 hours so a minimum total of 300 hours gets you to the Level 5):** in addition to completing the Level 2



Foundation Certificate and the Level 4 Equine Assisted Services Diploma you can elect further topics from the above selection of alternative topics, self-guided research and an extended written case study with the option of one extra online practice client session or two days onsite.

The provision of full support, mentoring and supervision is included throughout your training experience.

Timing:

- **externally accredited Level 4 (Irish Level 6) Equine Assisted Services Diploma:** inclusive of the Level 2 Foundation Certificate to be completed over a period of around nine to ten months;
- **externally accredited Level 5 (Irish Level 7) Equine Assisted Services Diploma:** will take an additional three to six months on completion of the Level 4 Equine Assisted Services Diploma.

Please note that the Athena team will consider requests to defer continuing your studies and to re-join the pathway to complete for example the externally accredited Level 4 Equine Assisted Services Diploma at a later stage after completion of the Level 2 Foundation Certificate and/or Level 5 Equine Assisted Services Diploma on a case by case basis to.

- **externally accredited Level 7 (Irish Level 9) PG Cert. in Equine Assisted Services** (includes for example Equine Assisted/Facilitated Learning, Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Psychotherapy depending on qualifications).

This can be taken as a standalone post-graduate qualification, provided that applicants have a Bachelors (UK Level 6) degree and a recognised qualification in Equine Facilitated Interactions (including Equine Facilitated/Assisted Learning, Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Psychotherapy etc).

This is a year-long qualification which focusses on a supervised independent action research project based around the practitioner's existing business.

The qualification is comprised of two short taught modules, and an extended research-based third, as follows:

- i) the skills required to develop your own research project, and engaging effective and appropriate tools to assess and analyse the impact of the project undertaken;
- ii) the different practices and approaches undertaken in the wider market of Equine Facilitated and Assisted Services and an objective reflective assignment based on these; and



- iii) the third module, which makes up the principal commitment of the qualification, is based the creation and execution of an extended programme of professional practice and research.

AAHEP is a Full Member of and also recognises and incorporates the important work undertaken by the International Association of Human-Animal Interactions Organisations (IAHAIO) in establishing a framework that “*provides best practice guidance for meeting the care, training and welfare requirements for equines involved in delivering equine-assisted services*”.

Professional Standards Authority ("PSA"): AAHEP, formerly the Athena Herd Foundation, has been liaising with the Professional Standards Authority since 2021 and is the first and currently only animal focussed UK National Accredited Practitioner Register (PSA) to have met the Service User test in 2022 to hold an Accredited Register regulated in the UK by the PSA (this is the same government-backed scheme aimed at protecting the public by helping them choose health and care professionals who are competent and trustworthy held by, for example, the bacp for Counsellors and Psychotherapists).

The AAHEP applies the same standards to non-UK residents who will have a Practitioner logo without the PSA Kite mark.

AAHEP Student Member: on completion of the Foundation Certificate individuals can apply to join AAHEP as a Student Member.

AAHEP Registered Practitioner (as applicable): on completion of the externally accredited Level 4 Equine Assisted Services Diploma, the application fee for joining the Register is



included in the price. Subject to then meeting the full requirements of the Accredited Practitioner Register annual membership fees (or pro rata equivalent thereof¹) are payable by practitioners.
