The Athena Herd Foundation is rapidly evolving into one of the largest Training Providers recognised in this field with an ever-growing authentic community and is a pioneering national and international specialist:

- **Level 2 ACCPH (Accredited Counsellors, Coaches, Psychotherapists and Hypnotherapists) Certificate in Equine Facilitated Interactions (Equine Facilitated Learning, Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Psychotherapy depending on qualifications, known in the market also as Equine Assisted Services, Learning, Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Psychotherapy and so forth).**

This can be taken as a standalone Certificate or as Module One of the full externally accredited ACCPH Level 4 and Level 5 Equine Facilitated Practitioner Diploma training programmes.

- **What is the time commitment?**
 - **ONSITE** *four full days of onsite experiential group learning and personal reflective practice; or*
 - **ONLINE** *30 hours over seven consecutive weeks interactive, experiential, distance learning (access to horses is required between the sessions)*

You will be able to really start to understand, develop and deliver work as an independent practitioner and build on the practical skills of the work with the support of the Athena Herd Foundation team and community (depending on your background and qualifications this can either be referred to as Equine Facilitated/Assisted Learning or Therapy (*i.e. Occupational Therapy, Counselling and, if appropriate, Psychotherapy*), provided you have the appropriate supporting qualifications). Material and a set of Equine Insights (cards) is provided to you to support you on your journey.

- **On completion of the Certificate, YOU are eligible to:**
 - be a **lifetime Member** of the Athena Herd Foundation national and international community at **no extra cost** which includes a private facebook community group within which referrals for work are made, knowledge is shared, CPD and CEU events as well as free annual networking and events and more are shared;
 - access to your unique log-in area with client and waiver form templates for your use (with more templates provided as your journey progresses);
 - include your details on the Members map on the athenaherd.org website;



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- display your unique Member logo on your own website and link back to the Athena Herd Foundation website (Athena can provide website/brand support as an addition);
- apply to join the international professional membership through the ACCPH as a minimum as an accredited Member: see accph.org.uk;
- take out professional indemnity insurance through the Athena Herd Foundation's Balens Affinity Scheme to be covered to do the work;
- consider the Westminster Indemnity insurance policies see athenaherd.org.

The Athena Herd Foundation also has international relationships with insurers in different jurisdictions that recognise its programmes including for example Equisure and Westminster Global both in the USA.

- **Externally Accredited ACCPH Level 4 (160 hours) and Level 5 (240 hours) Equine Facilitated Practitioner Diplomas**

On successful completion of the externally accredited ACCPH Level 2 Certificate in Equine Facilitated Interactions, you can continue your journey and build on your specialism whether that be working with individuals and/or groups, children and/or adults, looking to garner funding for the work, work with children, vulnerable adults, and/or corporates and move on to complete the externally accredited ACCPH Level 4 Equine Facilitated Practitioner Diploma and/or Level 5 Equine Facilitated Practitioner Diploma as follows:

- Level 4 Module Two (ONLINE):** three practical case-studies involving a minimum of ten sessions overall supported with supervision, delivery of a case study and mentoring plus two facilitated online group action learning sets and personal research. The goal is to really develop and build both on your practice from one session with a client(s) to supporting multiple client(s) sessions along with enhancing those questioning and clean language skills; **and**
- Level 4 Module Three (MIX):** interactive online topic learning and sessions to further develop and build on your practice (mindfulness and grounding, embodiment and somatic practices, empathy and social intelligence) supported also by the business and risk mitigation aspects including the provision of further appropriate templates (incorporating your business and considerations around data and insurance, risk assessments, policies and procedures, garnering funding and much more).

NEW TO 2024, for Level 4 qualification the business-related sessions can be swapped for one alternative topic where prior agreement by Athena is confirmed. This can be based upon confirmation of existing business experience or agreement to the inappropriateness of the content for learner. Any selected replacement topic needs to be pre-agreed with the Athena Herd team on application, before commencing Modules 2 and 3.

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The alternative topics are (one to be chosen for Level 4 learners):

- Working with young people
- Understand the nature of horses and the implications for Equine Facilitated work
- Mental Health awareness and support, and wellbeing benefits
- Capturing and recording the benefit of your work
- Working with Mindfulness
- Working with Corporate Clients

Please note that this module can be taken as a full distance learning module with the option of one extra online practice client session or you can opt to spend two days onsite.

- (iii) **Level 5 Equine Facilitated Practitioner Diploma:** in addition to completing Modules One, Two and Three you can elect further modules from the above selection of topics, self-guided research and an extended written case study with the option of one extra online practice client session or two days onsite.

The provision of full support, mentoring and supervision is included throughout your training experience.

Timing:

- **Level 4 externally accredited ACCPH Equine Facilitated Practitioner Diploma:** inclusive of Module One, Module Two and Module Three to be completed over a period of around nine to ten months;
- **Level 5 externally accredited ACCPH Equine Facilitated Practitioner Diploma:** will take an additional three to six months to complete on completion of the Level 4 Equine Facilitated Practitioner Diploma.

Please note that the Athena Herd Foundation team will consider requests to defer Modules Two and Three and re-join the pathway to complete the externally accredited ACCPH Level 4 Equine Facilitated Practitioner Diploma at a later stage after completion of the Certificate and/or Level 5 Equine Facilitated Practitioner Diploma on a case by case basis to.

- **Level 7 externally accredited ACCPH Post Graduate Certificate in Equine Facilitated Interactions (Equine Facilitated Learning, Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Psychotherapy depending on qualifications, known in the market also as Equine Assisted Services, Learning, Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Psychotherapy and so forth).** This can be taken as a standalone qualification provided that applicants have a Bachelors (UK Level 6) degree and a recognised qualification in Equine Facilitated Interactions (including Equine Facilitated/Assisted Learning, Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Psychotherapy etc).



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This is a year-long qualification which focusses on supervised individual independent research and analysis.

The qualification is comprised of two short taught modules, and an extended research-based third, as follows:

- i) the skills required to develop your own research project, and engaging effective and appropriate tools to assess and analyse the impact of the project undertaken (see below);
- ii) the different practices and approaches undertaken in the wider market of Equine Facilitated and Assisted Interactions and an objective reflective assignment based on these (see below), and;
- iii) the third module, which makes up the principal commitment of the qualification, is based the creation and execution of an extended programme of professional practice and research (see below).

Having said this, we fully acknowledge that a track system may not work for all horses and humans so in terms of the offering, the Athena Herd Foundation embraces an open and inclusive approach to your set-up in this space placing the focus on a commitment to the Ethical treatment of Horses, through standards of equine care building on the Friends, Freedom and Forage approach as published in the Horses Manifesto (2012) by the International Association of Animal Behaviour Consultants (IAABC) and the Five Domains model (2015).

Professional Standards Authority (“PSA”): the Athena Herd Foundation has been liaising with the Professional Standards Authority since 2021 and is the first animal focussed practitioner register to have met the Service User test in 2022 to hold an Accredited Practitioner Register regulated in the UK by the PSA (this is the same government-backed scheme aimed at protecting the public by helping them choose health and care professionals who are competent and trustworthy held by, for example, the bacp for Counsellors and Psychotherapists) The Athena Herd Foundation in any event applies the same standards to non-UK residents who will have an Accredited Practitioner logo without the PSA Kite mark. On completion of the externally accredited ACCPH Level 4 Equine Facilitated Practitioner Diploma, provided learners meet the requirements of the Register, year one to be on this Register is included in the current Module Two and Three pricing.
